Lake Maumelle Watershed Stewardship Council to meet

LITTLE ROCK — The Lake Maumelle Watershed Stewardship Council will meet at 10 a.m. Wednesday, August 5, 2009. The meeting location will be the Third Floor Board Room of Central Arkansas Water's (CAW) James T. Harvey Administration Building at 221 East Capitol Avenue in Little Rock.

The Watershed Stewardship Council is a community and inter-local group with the objective of establishing and supporting a strong partnership among organizations and entities that have significant authority or resources for managing the Lake Maumelle Watershed. Formation of the council was a key recommendation of Tetra Tech, Inc., consultant on the development of the Lake Maumelle Watershed Management Plan.

The Watershed Management Plan directs certain strategies to protect the water quality of Lake Maumelle, the primary drinking water supply for approximately 398,000 people in 16 cities and communities in Central Arkansas.
