# Pulaski Conservation District Programs

**Water Quality:** Access to safe and clean water by Pulaski County residents is a priority of the Pulaski Conservation District (PCD). The PCD in partnership with Central Arkansas Water is endeavoring to raise awareness of non-point source pollution.

**Education:** Conservation pamphlets, brochures, or just answers to questions can be obtained through the office. Activities include outdoor classroom plans and assistance, sponsoring essay and poster contests, involvement in Earth Day and Envirothon competition, and continuing teacher conservation education.

**Backyard Conservation:** The PCD provides technical assistance to urban and rural homeowners in areas such as home site drainage, erosion problems, and conducting site surveys to help determine feasibility of pond development and maintenance.

**Maps:** The PCD maintains, for public viewing, sets of topographical, aerial, flood, and wetland maps. Office aerial maps include 1967 and 1990 flights. There is no cost for 8" x 11" letter-size copies of maps or Pulaski County Soil Survey Books.

**Water Use Registration:** In accordance with Act 154 of 1991, the district will annually collect a \$10 registration fee for each irrigation surface and/or ground water relief and/or well used in Pulaski County. Irrigation water use may be registered at the PCD office October 1 through March 1 of each year for the previous cropping season.

**Beaver Control Program:** This Arkansas Natural Resources Commission program is carried out monthly through the PCD and provides a \$10 per tail bounty on trapped beavers in Pulaski County. Trappers must notify the district, complete forms, and negotiate with the landowner before trapping begins. Tails may be brought to the district office on the last Tuesday of each month between 8:30 a.m. and noon.
