5 **AN EMERGENCY ORDINANCE**

6
7 BE IT ENACTED BY THE QUORUM COURT OF PULASKI COUNTY, ARKANSAS,
8 AN ORDINANCE TO BE ENTITLED:

9
10 **AN ORDINANCE DEFINING THE AREA TO BE KNOWN AS THE LAKE**
11 **MAUMELLE WATERSHED, DECLARING AN EMERGENCY, AND FOR**
12 **OTHER PURPOSES.**

14 WHEREAS, proper planning is vital to the health, safety, and welfare of the residents
15 of Pulaski County, Arkansas; and,

16
17 WHEREAS, Lake Maumelle, the primary drinking water source for Central Arkansas,
18 provides some of the highest-quality drinking water in the country; and,

19
20 WHEREAS, the Pulaski County Planning Board (hereinafter "Planning Board")
21 recommended the adoption and enactment of a new Subdivision and Development
22 Code under the provisions of Ark. Code Ann. §14-17-201 et seq. The new Subdivision
23 Rules and Regulations will include provisions that apply to land development located
24 within the watershed of designated public water supply reservoirs; and,

26 WHEREAS, a large portion of the Lake Maumelle Watershed is located in Pulaski
27 County, Arkansas.

30 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Quorum Court of Pulaski County,
31 Arkansas:

33 Article 1. The legal description and map which are attached to this
34 Ordinance (as Exhibits A and B, respectively) and incorporated
35 herein, are hereby adopted by the Pulaski County Quorum Court
36 as the official designation of the area to be encompassed in the
37 Lake Maumelle Watershed.

39 Article 2. This area will be subject to all provisions of the Pulaski County
40 Subdivision and Development Code that apply to land development
41 located within the watershed of designated public water supply
42 reservoirs

44 Article 3. EMERGENCY CLAUSE: This ordinance, being necessary for the
45 preservation of the public peace, health, and safety, shall be in full
46 effect upon its adoption and signing.

48 Article 4. SEVERABILITY: If any part of this Ordinance is held invalid, such
