

City of Little Rock Fire Hydrant Testing

The Fire Department in coordination with Central Arkansas Water conducts fire hydrant tests twice a year — in April and October — to ensure the fire hydrants are operating properly and can be used in the event of a fire or other emergency that requires water.

- The increased flow of water from the fire hydrants during testing occasionally can result in discolored water at the customer's tap.
- The discolored water is bacteriologically safe but can stain clothing.
- DO NOT WASH clothing in the discolored water. Check for discolored water in your washing machine before washing clothes during designated fire hydrant testing periods for your area.
